CHALLENGE

It was observed that a national finance company was suffering from an exodus of employees who were leaving suddenly and joining competing organizations. The company suspected a coordinated effort against them but lacked concrete evidence to substantiate the claim.

The client needed information – was there evidence of coordination, data collection, or the unauthorized acquisition of clients and client information?
